Brief Description of Learning Experience: Using MovieMaker, I will present a mini movie I made on Susan B. Anthony to introduce the upcoming lesson. The students will watch the movie and then I will instruct them on how to make a movie of their own introducing another influential person from history. They will then thouroghly research the person they have chosen and construct a chronological movie. When the movies are completed, the students will be asked to present them to the class. Afterwards, I will post them on our classroom blog for parents to see. I will be critiquing the students' work, and the lesson should take 2-3 days to complete.

This is because students and teachers engage in higher-level critical thinking skills, and the students themselves are creating a project that is meaningful to an audience outside of the classroom.
